Inside Cabins (Category N)

Location on ship: various locations on deck 2, 3, 6, 7, or 8

Double Rate - **\$1,019.38 per person**

Outside Cabins (Category H)

Location on ship: deck 3 center or either deck 6 or 7 bow / stern

Double Rate - **\$1,284.38 per person**

Outside Cabins (Large Outside Cabin Category F)

Location on ship: various locations on deck 6, 7, 8, or 9

Double Rate - **\$1,324.38 per person**

Balcony Cabins (Category D2)

Location on ship: various locations on deck 6, 7, or 9

Double Rate - **\$1,584.38 per person**

Mini Suite (Category JS)

Location on ship: various locations on deck 8 or 9

Double Rate - **\$2,104.38 per person**

**Names, Birthdays, and Category Type are also due at the time of deposit.**

**The Jr. Suite category has an earlier deposit date. For this category, the deposit of \$500.00 is due on July 11, 2008.**

**You can call anytime before the deposit due date to give your names and desired category. Once names and desired category have been given, you will have 2 cabin options.**

- **The 1<sup>st</sup> option is "assign cabin". You can pick where your cabin will be. If you do this, your cabin will not change. The deposit due date will be 30 days from the date you assign the cabin.**
- **The 2<sup>nd</sup> option is "leave as guarantee". This means that you let Royal Caribbean decide where your cabin will be located. You will be guaranteed the category that you choose but also eligible for a possible cabin upgrade.**

**Any cabins that have not received payment by the deposit due date will automatically cancel after September 9, 2008.**
